Proposal for .22lr

Underlying premise

- Everyone has a .22lr
- Nearly everyone still has their first .22lr
- There is no single type of .22lr sitting in the closet:
  - Action type: bolt, semiauto, lever, pump
  - Magazine: tube or box
  - Sights: iron or optic
  
- Maximum Point Blank Range (MPBR) for .22lr is 50 to 60 yards

The .22lr presents an opportunity to bring more people, particularly young shooters into the shooting sports and therefore into this club.

1. Youth benefit
  - a. Can be used as the practical component of hunter safety
  - b. Can be used to foster parental involvement in the summer, during the week, when the ranges aren't being fully used.
  
2. The obvious "fun" factor for everyone.
  
3. Cheap practice
  
4. Practical/tactical .22lr shooting is growing in popularity
  - a. National Rifle League .22
  - b. Long Range Rifle Shooters of Utah

Implementation of a .22lr shooting program

- First and foremost, it must be simple and it must be fun.
- Program must encourage people to bring out whatever they have without being dragged into a competitive "arms race"
  - Limit the distances to 50 yards, the MPBR
  - No time limits
  
- Targets
  - Should be simple to set up
  - Should be portable

- Should be “reactive” with the shooter to get instantaneous feed back on whether or not there’s a hit
- Should be self-sealing and self resetting so no further work once set up.
- Self sealing targets are an inexpensive one time expenditure
- No maintenance
- 50 yard limit in range makes all the facilities available for set up
  - We can set up at any range not being used – no interference with other events
  - Enables us to have a .22lr adjunct to any other shoot. In other words, you can unlimber your .22 lr while wait to shoot or after you are done shooting.
- First year plan – “Small things done are better than great things planned” (Peter Townsend, Chaplain to the US Senate)
  - Work with hunter safety
  - Do ad hoc testing of the various potential programs
    - A “youth shoot” in summer – single event
    - A series of three matches over the summer
      - A NRL22 match
      - A Utah Long Range match
      - A hunter warm-up in August
    - At least one or two of the matches should be run as an adjunct to a regular shoot
  - Evaluation with feedback from the shooters.
