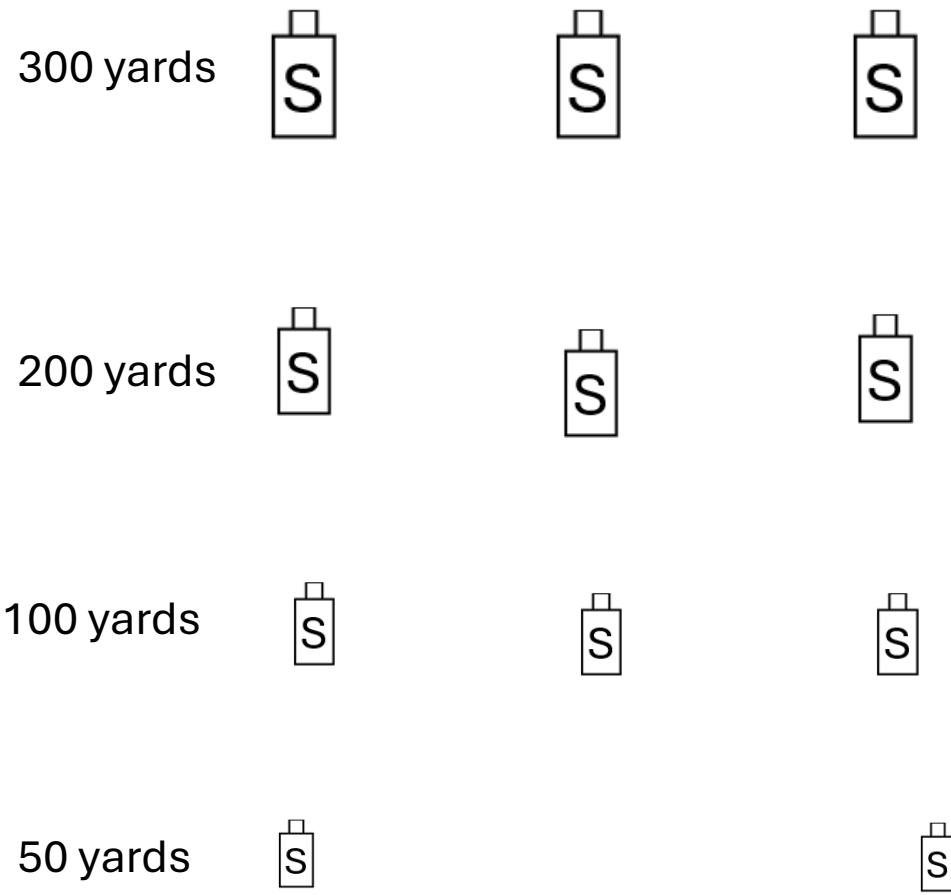


300 Yard rifle range



Shooter starts standing in shooters box, holding loaded rifle in low ready position with safety on. At signal, engage 11 targets from near to far with one round per target from 3 shooting positions, positions may be shot in any order, but all positions must be used.

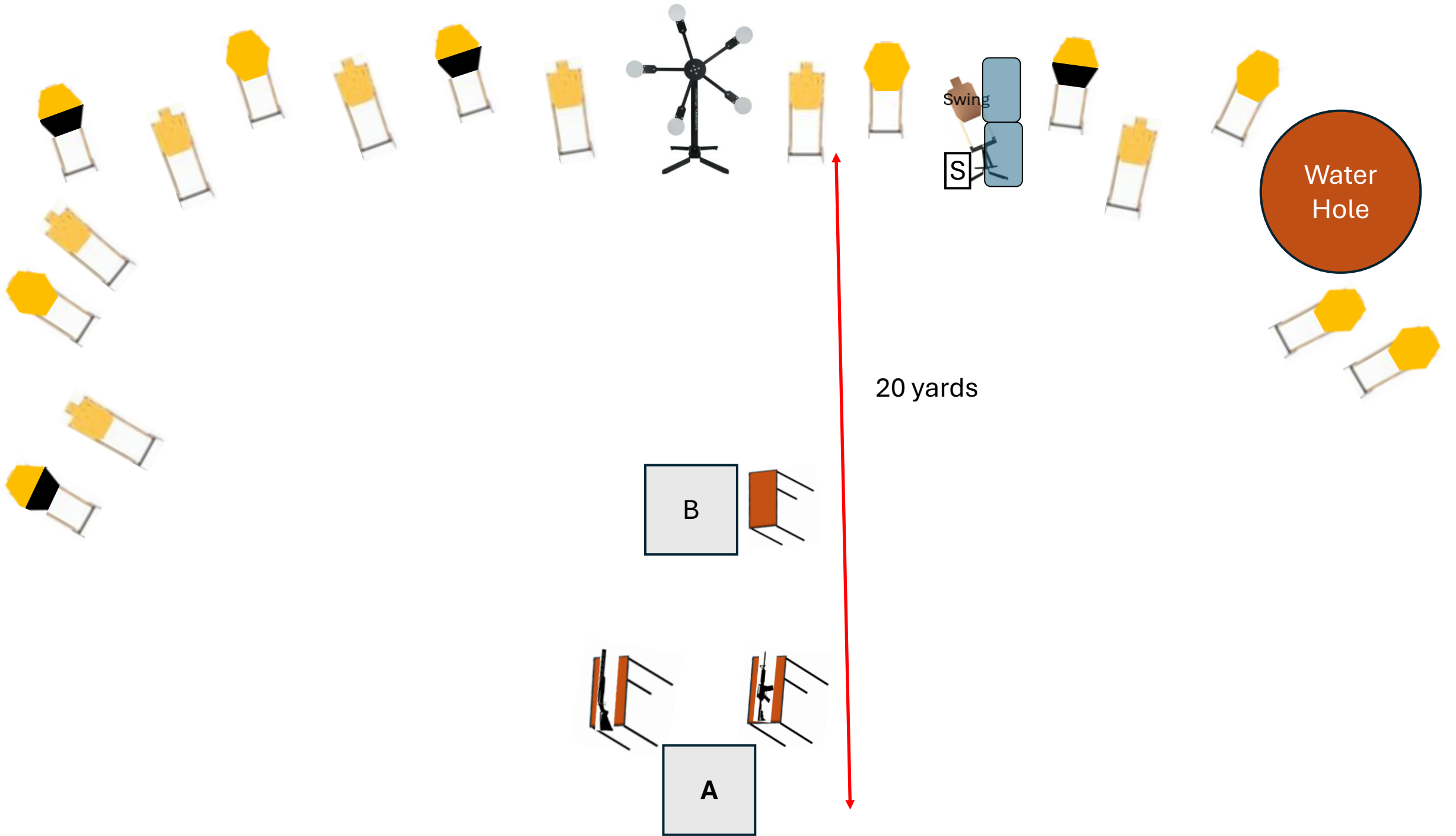
Table: shooter must be seated in chair and rifle with support on table.

Ladder: any rung can be used, rifle must contact a rung, support may be used.

Spool: Rifle (support may be used) must contact the top of spool.

Comstock

33 rounds total (11 shots per prop)



3 gun shooters

Shotgun loaded with 5 rounds only, gun on table. Extra rounds may be stored at shooters discretion, but not loaded in gun

Rifle loaded to capacity on table.

Pistol loaded to capacity and holstered.

Hands relaxed at sides.

At signal engage Texas star with shotgun from box A, you may add extra rounds if needed once shotgun is empty.

Ground shotgun on table, retrieve rifle and engage Hexagon Rifle targets with 2 shots each. Ground rifle on table.

Advance to box B and engage USPSA targets using pistol with 2 shots each.

PCC shooters

Shotgun loaded with 5 rounds only, gun on table. Extra rounds may be stored at shooters discretion, but not loaded in gun.

PCC loaded to capacity on table.

At signal engage Hexagon rifle targets with 2 shots each from box A, when complete ground PCC on table.

Retrieve shotgun and engage Texas star, when complete ground shotgun on table.

Retrieve PCC and advance to box B, engage USPSA targets using PCC with 2 shots each.
