REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

Weapons:

- Semi-auto pistol of your choice
- Pistol Holster Required: Outside the Waistband Only
 - **Restrictions:** For safety reasons none of the following will be allowed - NO nylon, soft animal skinned, collapsable, shoulder holsters, fanny pack draw type or Serpa Brand
 - **Allowed:** Any Kydex, Safariland, Blackhawk or other similar product (complete Discretion of the Lead Instructor).
- AR-15 or M-4 style rifle with either iron sights, aimpoint or similar red dot system.
- **Sling required.**

Magazines:

- Pistol Magazine Pouch
- 3 Pistol Magazines
- 3 Rifle Magazines
- Cargo pants with multiple pockets or rifle magazine pouch for the belt

Ammunition:

- 150 Rounds Good Quality Pistol Ammo
- 150 Rounds Good Quality Rifle Ammo

Not Allowed: Reloads, armor piercing, green tip or tracer rounds permitted.

Other: Hat, eye and hearing protection, long sleeves, long pants with pants belt, sun screen, bug spray, fluids, note taking materials.

FOR SAFETY REASONS: ANY / ALL EQUIPMENT IS AT THE COMPLETE DISCRETION OF THE LEAD INSTRUCTOR

OBJECTIVES:

This class will familiarize the student with the basic concepts of utilizing the AR-15 rifle in conjunction with transitioning to a pistol back up weapon. Safely conducting rifle and pistol reloads along with transitions when required. Common weapon malfunctions and fixes will be discussed. In addition to the proper use of cover and barricades for either personal protection or home defense.

Over his police career, Dennis has received several merit awards which include Medal of Valor for Combat, Meritorious Service, and the Distinguished Service Award.

Previously, Dennis served on the Association of SWAT Personnel - Wisconsin Board of Directors. There he authored articles which have been published in the Association of SWAT Personnel – Wisconsin (ASP) newsletters that focused on tactical and firearms training, firearms, SWAT team personnel selection and SWAT team training. Dennis has been recognized and awarded the highest State of Wisconsin individual SWAT Award (Paul W. ROEMER) for his contributions to the SWAT Community. Plus, he was on three separate occasions recognized on the SWAT Team of the Year for actions taken during Tactical Operations,

Currently, Dennis is on the staff at the Waukesha County Technical College / Law Enforcement Division as a Lead Firearms and Tactics Instructor for police in service. He is also the Lead Training Instructor at the Wisconsin Firearms Training Center located in Brookfield, Wisconsin working with civilian 2A enthusiasts who are focused on improving their shooting skills. Dennis has worked with thousands of officers and civilians during his career. In 2023, Dennis started his own training company, Tier 1 Training & Tactics LLC, which is focused on providing practical reality-based training for the real world that produces positive results.
